If a student is at school with cold or flu-like symptoms, normal procedures will occur including phoning the parent/carer and the student should be kept until well.

Preventative measures are in place in all WA Public schools:

- Cancellation of all non-essential events such as assemblies, incursions, excursions etc.
- Social distancing routines and practices.

Other preventative measures are also in place including:

- Use of soap and hand sanitiser.
- Used own drink bottles, cups, cutlery, etc.
- Student education is reiterated in classrooms regularly including COVID-19 awareness lessons, hand washing practices, teaching the management of coughing, sneezing and blowing noses, etc.
- General school cleanliness (including disinfectant spray, wiping surfaces, work station cleaning, use own equipment.)
