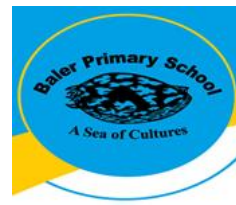


# COVID-19 Advice for Students, Staff, Parents, Families, Volunteers, Contractors, Visitors.



Have you travelled overseas recently or been in contact with any confirmed cases of COVID-19?

### Action required:

- **Phone or Email** the school. It is important that you communicate with the school so we can record your child's or your absence appropriately.
- **Implement 14 day isolation** from the last day in the country visited or contact with a confirmed case.

Following this isolation period, with no symptoms - students may return to school. No medical certificate is required.

### Action required:

If flu-like symptoms appear, seek medical advice and continue to self-isolate.

**Please notify the school via phone or email when you are clear to return.**

### Confirmed Case

The school will be advised by the Chief Health Officer.

Do you or does your child have a medical condition or fall into the risk category?

**NO** - attend school or advise school of reason for non attendance

If a student is at school with cold or flu-like symptoms, normal procedures will occur including phoning the parent/carer and the student should be kept until well.

Preventative measures are in place in all WA Public schools:

- Cancellation of all non-essential events such as assemblies, incursions, excursions etc.
- Social distancing routines and practices.

Other preventative measures are also in place including:

- Use of soap and hand sanitiser.
- Used own drink bottles, cups, cutlery, etc.
- Student education is reiterated in classrooms regularly including COVID-19 awareness lessons, hand washing practices, teaching the management of coughing, sneezing and blowing noses, etc.
- General school cleanliness (including disinfectant spray, wiping surfaces, work station cleaning, use own equipment.)
